A small treat, a cozy item, or a thoughtful gesture can bring a little joy.



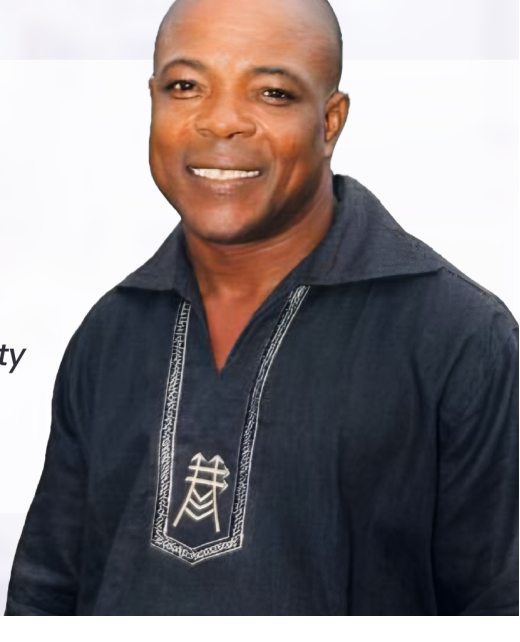
Prepare for the long journey

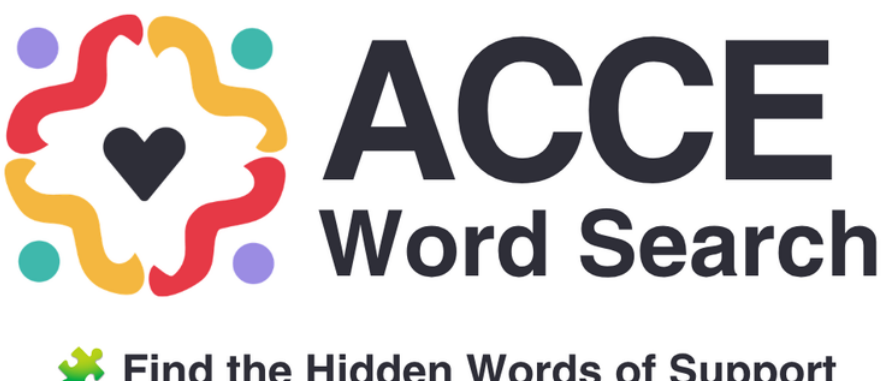


Patient Sotry

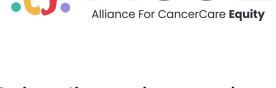
